Table 13: Techniques for Preventing Auto-PEEP in Mechanically Ventilated Patients and for Minimizing It When Present.

Aggressively treat airflow obstruction

Inhaled bronchodilators

Systemic corticosteroids

Aggressive clearance of secretions

Maximize expiratory time

Decrease overall minute ventilation (especially if pH > 7.40)

Increase inspiratory flow rate to 90-100 L/min

Exchange large-bore disposable ventilator circuit for non-disposable,

low compressible-volume circuit

Decrease patient's inspiratory work of breathing when auto-PEEP is present

If patient is making spontaneous inspiratory efforts, add external PEEP to 80%

of measured or estimated auto-PEEP level
